







The Main House

View from Master Bedroom Terrace




Guest Houses







Pasture and Meadows

Livestock and Wildlife










Idyllic Country Privacy


Located at the center of the 452 acre estate, the historic manor home and guest homes are physically isolated by 2.5 miles of Rapidan River boundary, rolling hills and mature forest. This creates a naturally protected family compound with infinite possibilities for future generations.









The Rapidan River

Edgewood has more than two miles of frontage along the Rapidan River , a fresh clean stream that flows out of the Blue Ridge Mountains to the West. The river boasts a enough bass, catfish and bluegill to get even the most avid angler busy.







Two Recreational Lakes

Edgewood has two large spring-fed lakes. One, 2.5 acres in size, is well stocked with bass, brim, perch, catfish and trout. It has a dock with a gazebo for waterfront parties and fishing. The smaller pond is 1.75 acres and is stocked with many catfish, bass, etc. It is a serious fisherman's lake.
